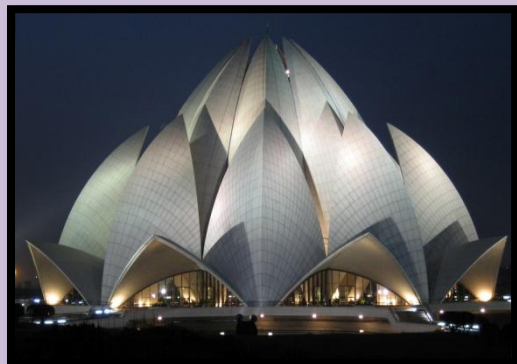


DELHI TEMPLE TOUR

Morning: Our car will pick you up & then proceed for Delhi Temple tour of Delhi.

The **Lotus Temple**, located in New Delhi, India, is a Bahai House of Worship completed in 1986. Notable for its flowerlike shape, it serves as the Mother Temple of the Indian subcontinent and has become a prominent attraction in the city. The Lotus Temple has won numerous architectural awards and been featured in hundreds of newspaper and magazine articles. Like all other Bahai Houses of Worship, the Lotus Temple is open to all, regardless of religion, or any other distinction, as emphasized in Bahai texts. The Bahai laws emphasize that the spirit of the House of Worship be that it is a gathering place where people of all religions may worship God without denominational restrictions. The Bahai laws also stipulate that only the holy scriptures of the Bahai Faith and other religions can be read or chanted inside in any language; while readings and prayers can be set to music by choirs, no musical instruments can be played inside.



Afternoon: Visit **ISKON TEMPLE-** International Society for Krishna Consciousness (ISKCON), known colloquially as the **Hare Krishna movement** or **Hare Krishna's**, is a Gaudiya Vaishnava religious organisation. ISKCON was founded in 1966 in New York City by A. C. Bhaktivedanta Swami Prabhupada who is worshipped by followers. Its core beliefs are based on select traditional Hindu scriptures, particularly the Bhagavad-Gita and the srimad Bhagavatam. ISKCON says it is a direct descendant of Brahma-Madhva-Gaudiya Vaishnava Sampradaya. The appearance of the movement and its culture come from the Gaudiya



Vaishnava tradition, which has had adherents in India since the late 15th century and Western converts since the early 1900s in America, and in England in the 1930s.

Later, Visit The Laxminarayan Temple (also known as the *Birla Mandir*) is a Hindu temple dedicated to Laxminarayan in Delhi, India. Laxminarayan usually



refers to Vishnu, Preserver in the Trimurti, also known as Narayan, when he is with his consort Lakshmi. The temple, inaugurated by Mahatma Gandhi, was made built by B. R. Birla and Jugal Kishore Birla from 1933 and 1939. The side temples are dedicated to Shiva, Krishna and Buddha.

Evening: Drive back to Venue/Hotel.
